


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
- 2. Solve the problems.
 - a) There are 35 3-headed monsters at a concert. How many heads are there in the concert hall?




c) Lee has a lot of books about monsters! In his bookcase, he has 4 shelves of 17 books on monsters. How many books on monsters does he have?
